Not only does this scheme provide an opportunity for people to gain both experience and a professional qualification, it also allows us to help create a more skilled workforce for Wales.



NRW APPRENTICESHIPS

Cyfoeth is an ICT apprentice scheme developed by Natural Resources Wales built upon a Welsh Government framework. Our scheme provides high quality structured training programmes that combines classroom learning with real on the job experience.

NRW is currently offering opportunities in the following fields:

- Network engineers
- Programmers
- Server engineers
- Spatial systems developers
- Database administration
- Service desk
- Project Management and support



WHY CHOOSE A NRW CYFOETH SCHEME?

As a NRW Cyfoeth apprentice, you will receive:

- A competitive training wage with opportunities for a rewarding career in ICT
- A fully funded training scheme with international industry recognised qualifications
- A thorough mentorship programme from industry experts.

WHAT DOES A NRW APPRENTICESHIP INVOLVE?

As a NRW apprentice, you will work in our ICT department for four days a week and one day a week in a more formal classroom based learning environment. Our scheme is predominantly based in Bangor although you will be expected to travel to other NRW locations throughout Wales.

You will be allocated a workplace supervisor who will guide your day to day work, give you advice and act as a mentor and career coach during your apprenticeship.

You will also have the opportunity to participate in networking events and training activities where you can develop professional networks and gain the skills and knowledge you need to become a high performing ICT professional.

Our apprenticeships last from one to three years depending on the skills required.

On top of earning a competitive training wage, Welsh Government will pay for your course, tuition and exam fees. You will also be provided with paid study leave in order to attend your classes and exams.

WHO CAN APPLY?

Cyfoeth apprenticeships aren't just for people with a proven track record in ICT application.

Anyone with a logical mind, problem solving skills and a passion for developing technologies can excel in this incredibly fast paced sector.

Our apprenticeships are targeted to school or college leavers preferably with an ICT related A level.

All applicants must be aged 18 before 1st September 2013.
