## Welcome to Llyn Geirionnydd

Welcome to Llyn Geirionnydd (say gay-ree-ON-ith), reputedly the home of the 6th century poet Taliesin. The remains of a stone monument to him stand by the north bank.

It is difficult to imagine that this was a derelict industrial landscape in the 1870s. In fact, this car park lies on a waste tip near an old lead mine entrance. A tramway along the eastern lakeshore delivered lead ore to an aerial ropeway. This took the ore down to the Klondyke lead mill and mine 200 ft below the lake. The mill was powered by water from the lake.

Why not discover this beautiful lake on our waymarked trail. You can also cross Mynydd Deulyn to Llyn Crafnant.
