Cewch weld ffynidwydd Douglas, sef y coed mwyaf yng Nghoed y Brenin.

HIGHLIGHTS:
See the magnificent Douglas firs, the biggest trees in Coed y Brenin.

DISGRIFIAD: Llwybr cerdded gwych i'r teulu ger glan yr afon. Mae'r tir bron yn hollol wastad ac yn addas ar gyfer cadeiriau olwyn. Dilynwch yr arwyddion o'r maes parcio ar draws y safle picnic gwellog (gweler y panel dehongli 'Gwarchodlu'r Brenin').

DESCRIPTION: The trail to the 'King's Guards' is a great family riverside walk on almost flat ground and suitable for wheelchairs. Follow the waymarkers from the car park across the grassy picnic site (see the 'King's Guards' interpretation panel).

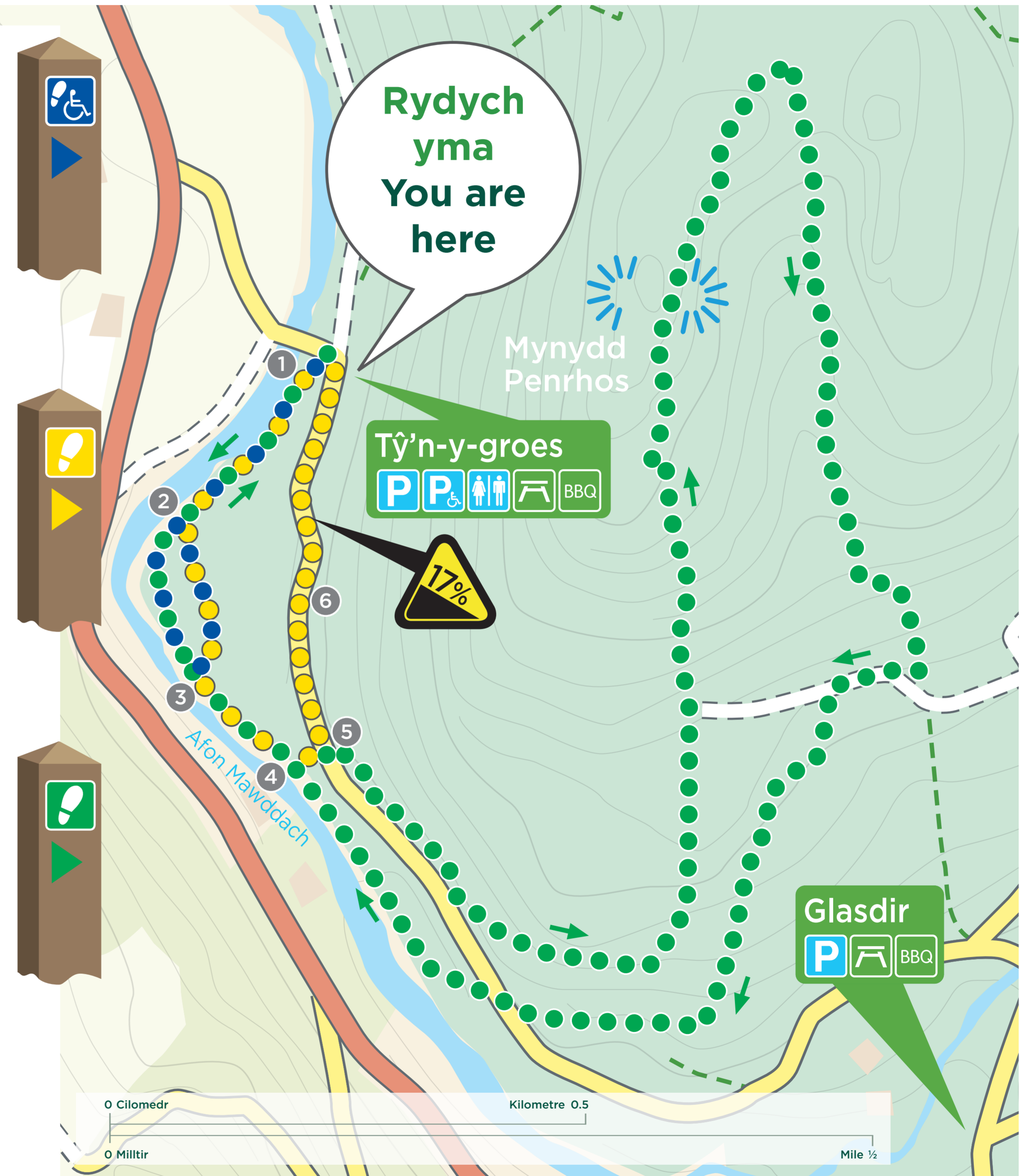

HIGHLIGHTS:
This trail offers a real feel of mountain walking with views of Y Garn, Cadair Idris and Rhobell Fawr - your reward for the slog up!

DISGRIFIAD: O'r maes parcio, croeswch yr ardal welltlog gan ddilyn yr arwyddion gwyrdd. Dilynwch yr afon nes i chi gyrraedd ffordd wedi'r tharmacio. Croeswch y ffordd a dilynwch y llwybr i fyny'r bryn nes cyrraedd copa Mynydd Penrhos gyda'i orchudd o rug ac eithin. Mae'r ffordd ar draws y mynydd ar hyd sawl llwybr troed serth ac anwastad.

DESCRIPTION: From the car park cross the grassy area following the green waymarkers. Follow the river until you reach a tarmac road. Cross the road and follow the route up the hillside to the heather and gorse-clad summit of Mynydd Penrhos. The trail across the mountain is on a number of steep footpaths on an unmade uneven surface.

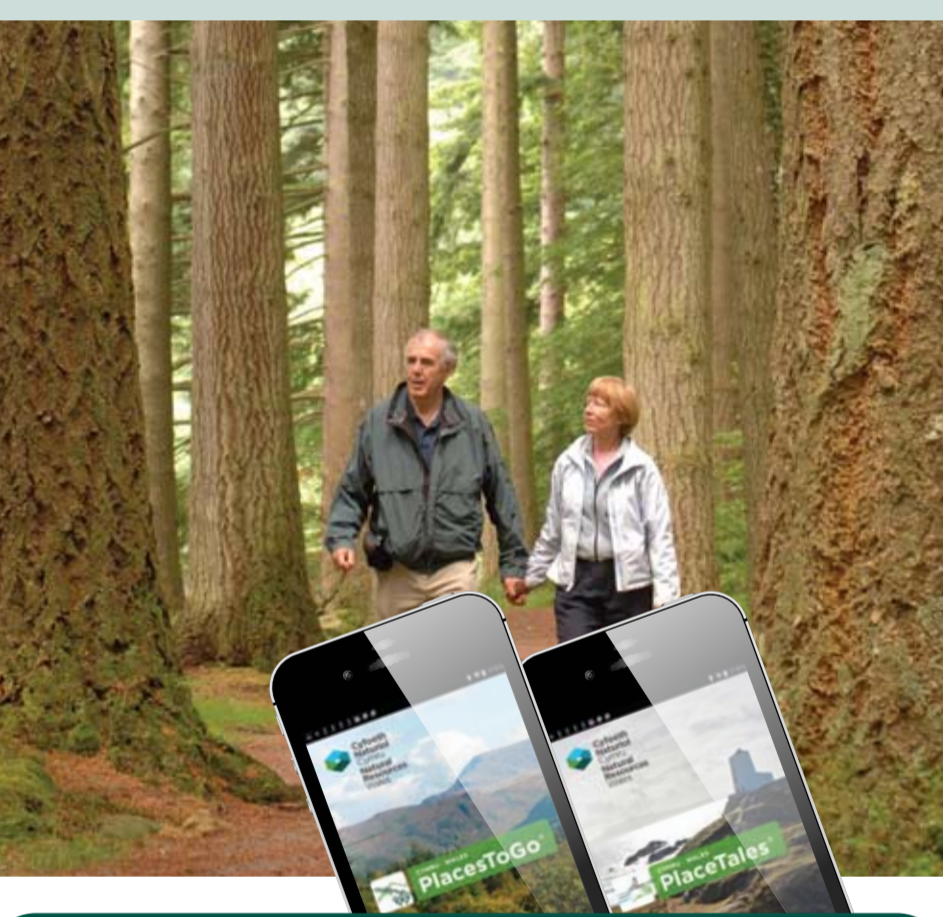


Croeso i Dŷ'n-y-groes
