**ALTERATION OF BOUNDARIES OF THE AFON CONWY,
ARDUDWY MARSH, GLASLYN-PENSYFLOG, GWENT,
HARLECH AND MAENTWROG, LLANFROTHEN,
MAWDDACH AND WNION
AND POWYSLAND (WALES) INTERNAL DRAINAGE DISTRICTS.**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Natural Resources Body for Wales has submitted to Welsh Ministers for confirmation, a Scheme under Section 3(1) of the Land Drainage Act 1991 making provision for the following matters:

- (i) the alteration of the boundaries of the Afon Conwy Internal Drainage District to exclude the land shown hatched green on the Afon Conwy Map;
- (ii) the alteration of the boundaries of the Ardudwy Marsh Internal Drainage District to exclude the land shown hatched green on the Ardudwy Marsh Map;
- (iii) the alteration of the boundaries of the Glaslyn-Pensyflog Internal Drainage District to exclude the land shown hatched green on the Glaslyn-Pensyflog Map;
- (iv) the alteration of the boundaries of the Gwent Internal Drainage District to—
 - (a) exclude the land shown hatched green on the Gwent Map; and
 - (b) include the land shown hatched blue on the Gwent Map;
- (v) the alteration of the boundaries of the Harlech and Maentwrog Internal Drainage District to exclude the land shown hatched green on the Harlech and Maentwrog Map;
- (vi) the alteration of the boundaries of the Llanfrothen Internal Drainage District to exclude the land shown hatched green on the Llanfrothen Map;
- (vii) the alteration of the boundaries of the Mawddach and Wnion Internal Drainage District to exclude the land shown hatched green on the Mawddach and Wnion Map;
- (viii) the alteration of the boundaries of the Powysland (Wales) Internal Drainage District to—
 - (a) exclude the land shown hatched green on the Powysland (Wales) Map; and
 - (b) include the land shown hatched blue on the Powysland (Wales) Map; and
- (ix) matters supplemental to or consequential on the alteration of boundaries.
