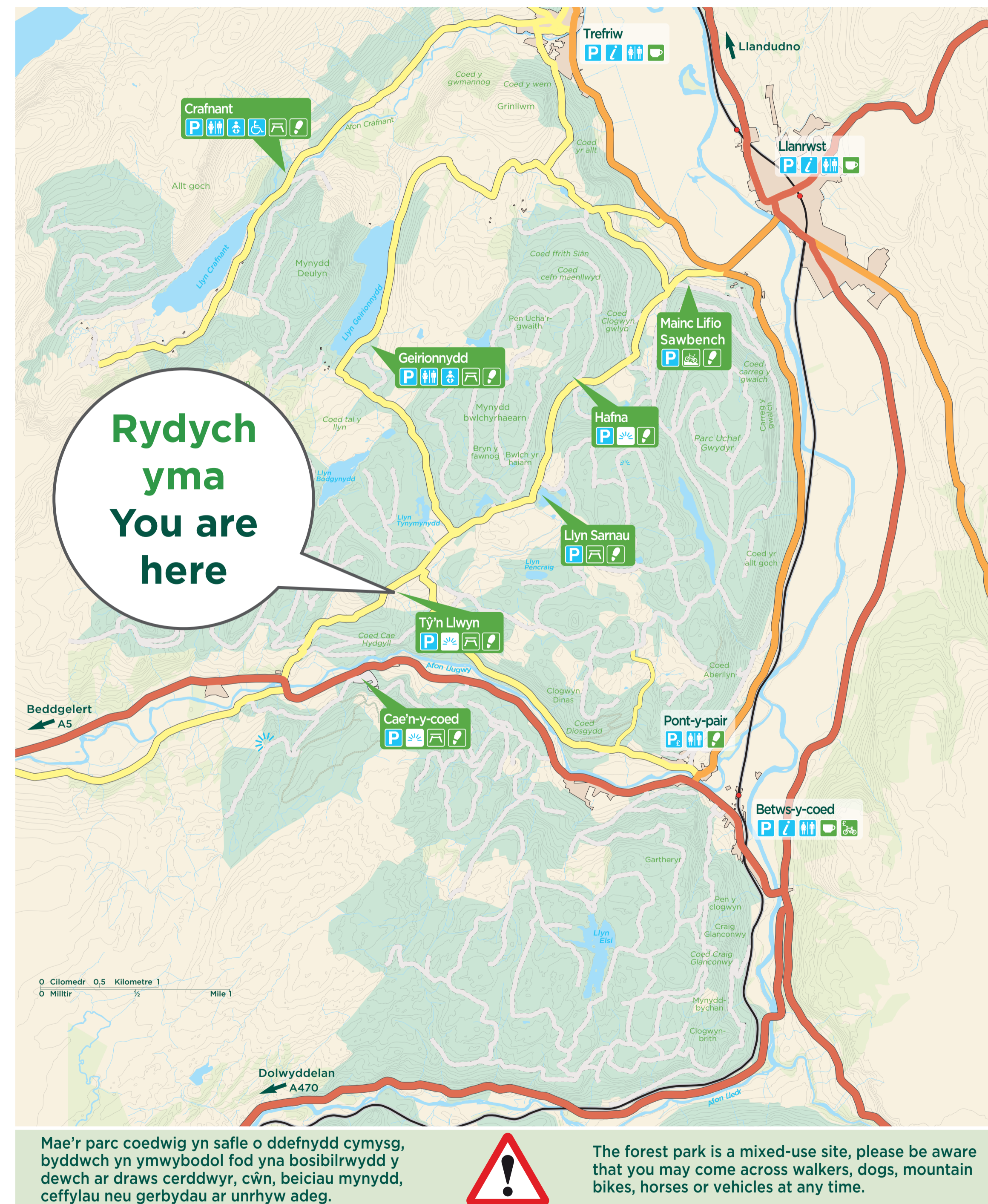

HIGHLIGHTS:

The spectacular Swallow Falls, and the viewpoints. A really lovely walk.
DESCRIPTION: This walk has a mixture of forest roads and narrow paths, some of which are stony and slippery when wet. There are several sets of steps and some steep climbs and descents. This path also crosses the Marin mountain bike trail in two places. Fast moving bikes may come up behind you very fast so please be aware of this.
